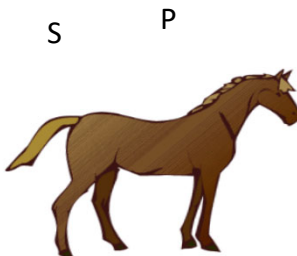
10 Revolver, 10 Rifle, 6+ Shotgun **Decoration Day**

Start: At position 2, at the ready. (hovering, not touching guns or ammo) Revolvers loaded with 5 rds. each and holstered. Rifle loaded with 10 rds., empty shotgun both staged anywhere safely. Shooter may indicate ready by saying **“From the Potomac to the Rio Grande”**

On Signal: with Rifle at position 2 engage must kill knockdown rack until down, any remaining rds. place on R1 for a total of 10 rounds revolvers, engage P1-P3 with a 4-2-4 sweep starting on either end. With shotgun knockdown 4 shotgun targets from position 1

Waterloo, New York

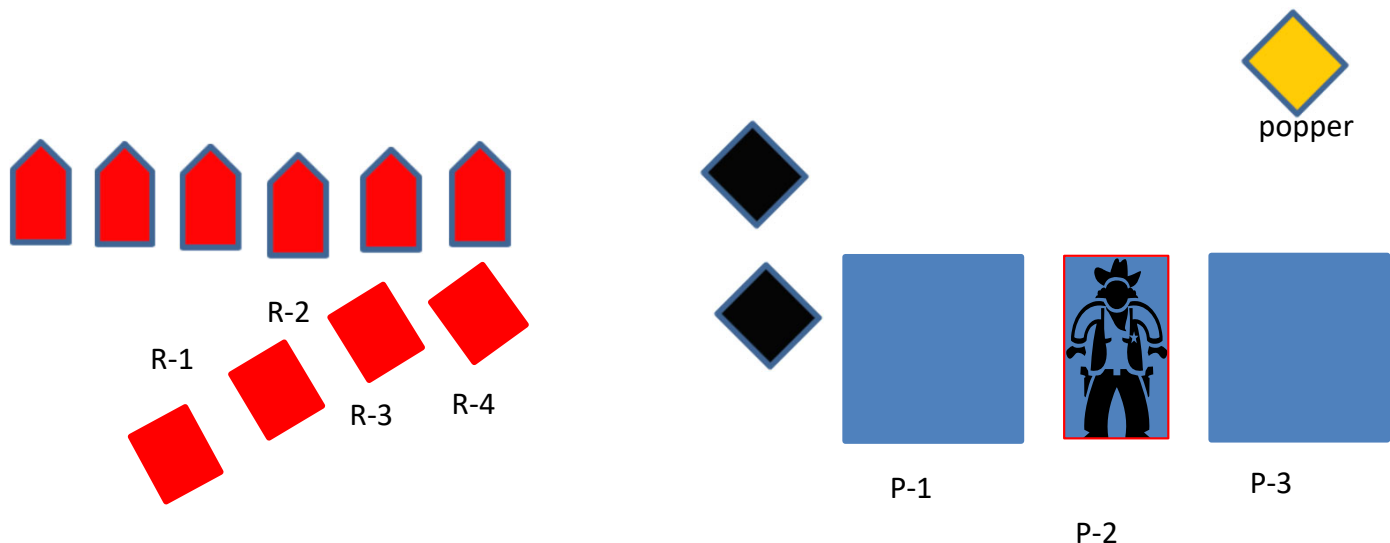
10 Revolver, 10 Rifle, 2+Shotgun

Start: At any position hands on hat or head. Revolvers loaded with 5 rds. Each and holstered. Rifle loaded with 10 rds. and Shotgun staged anywhere safely. Firearms used in any order, rifle cannot be last. Shooter may indicate ready by saying **“The beginning”**

On Signal: With rifle at position 1 engage the knockdown rack and knockdown targets R1,2,3,4 any order.

At position 2, knockdown the 2 shotgun targets. Then, If any plates are left up, engage popper for each standing plate.

With pistols at position 2 engage P targets in a double tap Nevada sweep starting on any target

10 Revolver, 10 Rifle 4+ shotgun

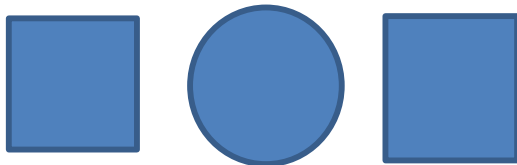
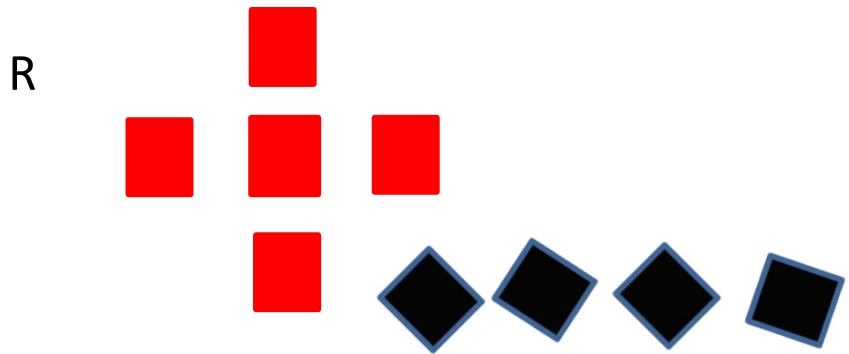
“Start: at any position, first firearm in hand(s) Rifle loaded with 10 rds, Revolvers loaded with 5 rds. and holstered or in hand(s), shotgun and rifle staged safely or in hands. Shooter may indicate ready by saying **“Known But to God”**

On Signal: With rifle, at position 2 engage the four “R” targets with a clockwise(cw) or counter clockwise(ccw) direction for 4 rounds, last round in center, repeat the instructions for the next 5 rounds

With shotgun at position 2, knockdown 4 SG targets

With revolvers, at position 1, 2-1-2 sweep the targets from one direction, repeat instructions from opposite direction

Rifle cannot be last

Arlington

10 *Revolver*, 10 *Rifle*, 2 +*Shotgun*

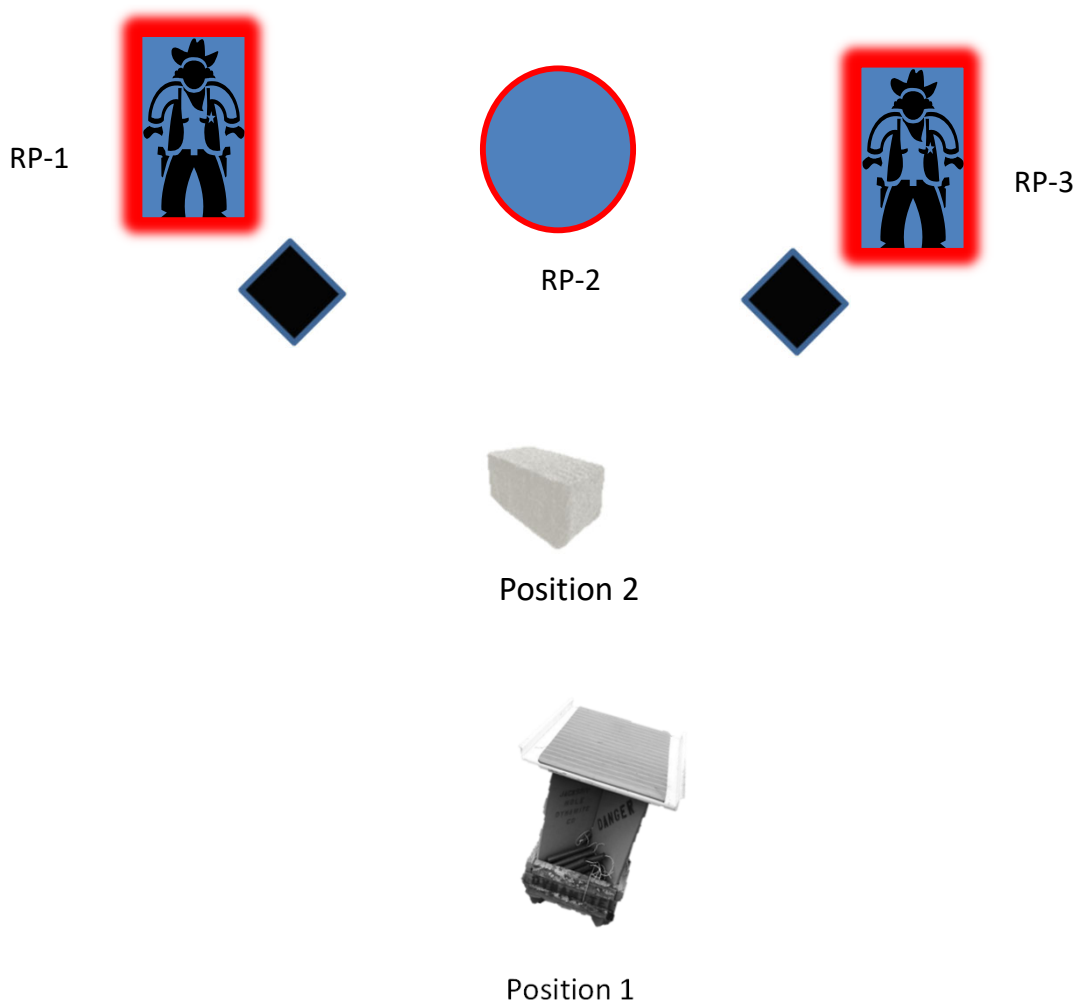


Start: At position 1 holding the corn cob pipe at position 1. Revolvers loaded with 5 rds. Each and holstered. Rifle loaded with 10 rds. and Shotgun staged anywhere safely. Shooter may indicate ready by saying “**Hallowed Ground**”

On Signal: At position 1, knockdown 2 shotgun targets

At position 1 with rifle, engage RP targets with an Arlington Sweep, left, left, left, right, left (1,1,1,2,1) then right, right, right, left, right (3,3,3,2,3)

At position 2 with revolvers repeat rifle instructions

10 *Revolver*, 10 *Rifle*, 4 + *Shotgun*



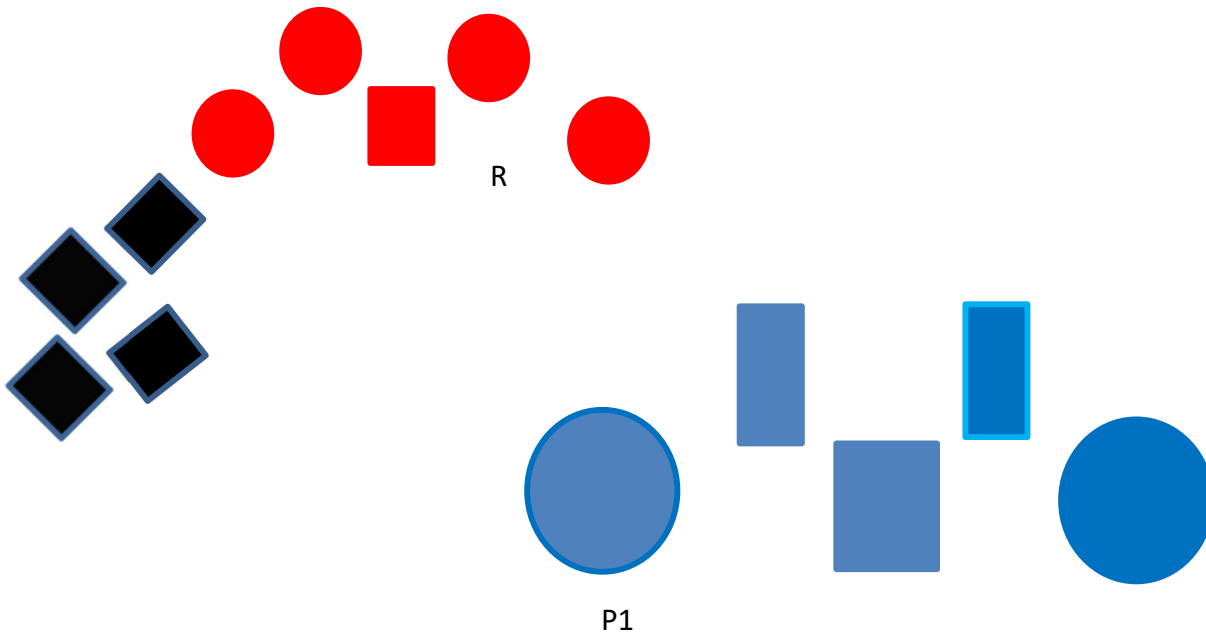
REMEMBRANCE DAY
Lest We Forget

Start: At position 1 first firearm in hand(s). Revolvers loaded with 5 rds. Each and holstered or in hand(s). Rifle loaded with 10 rds. and Shotgun staged safely or in hands. Firearms used in any order, rifle cannot be last. Shooter may indicate ready by saying “**Lest we Forget**”

On Signal: At position 1, knockdown 4 shotgun targets

At position 1 with rifle, engage R targets in a double sweep, either direction starting on either end,

At position 1 with revolvers repeat rifle instructions with P targets
